## Press Release: SOLIDARITY WITH THE SEATTLE-BRANCH IWW MILITANT SHOT AND WOUNDED DURING DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST TRUMP'S INAUGURATION. APPEAL FOR DONATIONS.

On January 20, 2017, at a protest rally against Trump's inauguration, the political stances he embodies and against the white nationalist misogyny he promotes, a Seattle-based Industrial Workers of the World (IWW) activist and member of the organization's General Defense Committee, was shot and wounded in the stomach at Washington University in Seattle. This man is also a long-standing anti-fascist activist.

Doubts remain about the origin of the shooting, though it appears likely to have been the work of an extreme rightwing activist whose organization had called for a counter-demonstration.

This act speaks mountains about the reactionary movement active today in Seattle, Paris and throughout Europe.

Hospital fees are very expensive, and this activist will find himself temporarily without any source of income. CNT-F also calls on our friends to participate in the financial solidarity campaign launched by IWW Montréal.

An injury to one is an injury to all!
